Throughout all the competition rounds, candidates will be accompanied by an orchestra: in the first round by the orchestra of the HEMU - High School of Music in Lausanne- and in the second round and final by Kremerata Baltica.

All the competitors not admitted to the second or final round will have

the opportunity to attend a free violin masterclass, run by jury members. Candidates not selected at each round will join the jury for the following round and will take part in public performances and concerts.

In the first round the candidates will play as well in duo among themselves in duo and the finalists will play in duo with members of the jury.

Concertino (Only 1st or 2nd or 3rd mvt.)

2nd mvt. of Concerto for Two Violins in D minor, BWV 1043, with a member of the jury (First violin part to be played by the candidate)
