Brindusa Burrows is a Swiss visual artist, curator and lecturer. She works in painting, printing and textile art using ink, fiber, charcoal, acrylic paints and paper. Her work was exhibited in Switzerland and Europe, has received the encouragement of the Luxembourg Art Prize commission between 2021-2023 and can be found in private collections.

In her creative process she navigates between spontaneity and intention.
